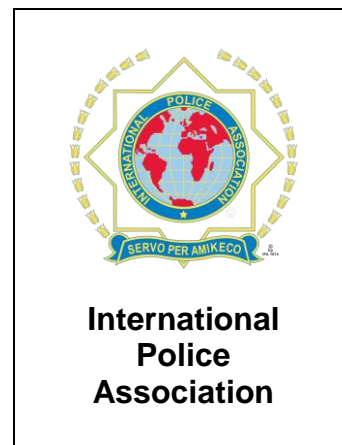

6 months	= 4 March (IS motions)
4 months	= 4 May (IR, Directive and Procedural document motions)
90 days	= 6 June (Any other discussion items for the Agenda)

IPA World Police Prize

Nominations are invited for the IPA World Police Prize. According to the Procedure document (see **Appendix 'E'**), the WPP may be awarded to any individual or organisation for exceptional services rendered to the police service; to the IPA; or for the benefit of society on matters of human rights or the preservation of World Peace. Please send nominations and any relevant documentary evidence or supporting material to the IAC no later than 29th February 2012.

Olympic Games 2012 - Section UK

The 2012 Olympic and Paralympic Games are being hosted in London and other UK towns and cities during July, August and September.

Section UK has received requests from overseas members asking for UK members to buy tickets on their behalf. The games are a friendship and sporting event. The IPA does not have an allocation of tickets and is not able to purchase tickets on behalf of others. Information about buying tickets can be found on the official website at www.london2012.com.

This year's games will be a challenge for the UK Police Service. Many officers will be sent to London (and other locations) from across the UK to assist with policing the games, with officers being away from home for several days at a time. It will not be possible either for serving police officers or IPA members to arrange visits or access to any of the Olympic venues.
